

HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Guidelines for Nomination:

Honorary life membership maybe bestowed from time to time to any member or ex-member of the College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand – NZNO in recognition of their contribution to emergency nursing in New Zealand. Such membership is rare and unusual.

These contributions may include:

- A personal and positive impact on emergency nursing in New Zealand.
- Activities on a national and international level which has increased the status and public recognition for emergency nurses in New Zealand.
- Promotion of the work and aims of the College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand – NZNO in a significant manner.
- Involved in or be involved with developing best practice guidelines and advancing emergency nursing in New Zealand through research.

Requirements and processes:

1. All nominations must be sent to the National Committee secretary by 1st March each year, using the official form (available from The Secretary, PO Box 2128, Wellington).
2. Any member, group of members or region may nominate an individual for Honorary life membership.
3. Honorary life membership will be voted on at the Annual General Meeting of CENNZ.
4. Approval of the person being nominated does not have to be sought.
