



## College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand (NZNO) MEDXUS Nursing Research Award

### **Aim:**

To promote and fund research related to the practice of emergency nursing.

### **Requirements:**

- The applicant must be a member of College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand (CENNZ) and of the New Zealand Nurses Organisation.
- Applicants must submit a proposal stating the research question, relevance of the research question to emergency nursing, and the intended research methodology.
- The research proposal must be approved by the relevant ethics authority. Proof of ethics approval may be requested by the CENNZ committee.
- The successful applicant is required to either report their research findings to the annual College of Emergency Nurses NZ - NZNO conference or to submit an article reporting their research findings for publication in Emergency Nurse NZ in the year following receipt of the award.

### **Closing date:**

Applications close 31st January each year.

### **Choosing the successful applicant**

The successful applicant will be decided by the CENNZ National Committee at the next committee meeting after the closing date. The Committee's decision is final, and there is no appeal process. All applicants will be notified in writing of the committee's decision after this meeting.

### **Value of the award**

\$1000.00 sponsored by MedXus.

### **Presentation:**

Payment of the award will be made by cheque when the successful applicant is notified. The award will be acknowledged by presentation of a certificate at the CENNZ annual conference. A representative of MedXus will be invited to present the award, which will otherwise be presented by the Chairperson of the CENNZ committee. All costs associated with attending the conference to receive the award and to present the research findings remain the responsibility of the recipient of the award.
