



College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand-NZNO Kirsty Morton Award

- This award is made annually in memory of Kirsty Morton, a widely respected emergency nurse and triage course instructor who worked at Tauranga Hospital Emergency Department. Kirsty set high standards for herself and for others, and exemplified the qualities that all emergency nurses aspire to. This award recognises a nurse who achieves a high standard while undertaking the New Zealand National Triage Course on behalf of the College of Emergency Nurses NZ / NZNO.
- The award will be a contemporary textbook related to emergency nursing with a maximum value of \$250.00
- The Kirsty Morton award will be presented to a participant in the National Triage Course identified by the triage course coordinator and instructors as an outstanding student.
- The recipient of the award will be announced at the annual CENNZ conference.
- The recipient of the award will be selected by the triage coordinator in consultation with the triage instructors. Their selection will be based on their observation and assessment of all course participants. The triage coordinator will write a brief citation for publication in the journal and to be read at the AGM supporting the recipient's selection.
- The triage coordinator's decision will be final.

Criteria

- (1) Current financial CENNZ-NZNO member
- (2) Successful completion of Triage of course
- (3) Term: Year preceding AGM at which award is presented.
