



College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand-NZNO Pacific Islands Nurses Grant

As part of the college's intent to nurture and support our colleagues in the Pacific, the College of Emergency Nurses New Zealand (CENNZ-NZNO) offers an annual grant of \$1000.00 to allow a CENNZ-NZNO member to work with our Pacific colleagues. It is expected that this grant will be put towards the cost of travel to the Pacific, for nurses interested in voluntary work. Preference will be given to those wishing to work with recognised health professionals in the region. It is envisaged this will encourage greater sharing of knowledge and expertise between the groups. The successful applicant will be expected to write an article on their return for Emergency Nurse NZ (the journal of CENNZ-NZNO), sharing their experience.

The applicant should apply in writing to the CENNZ-NZNO committee, and should include the following information in their application.

- Current New Zealand nursing registration.
- Current NZNO-CENNZ membership.
- Curriculum Vitae. (One page summary).
- Submit a brief essay (200 words) describing interest in Pacific healthcare and how relationships could be further developed with our Pacific colleagues.
- Character reference in support of your application.

Closing date for applications is the 31st of January. Evaluation of applications will be completed by the CENNZ-NZNO committee at their February meeting. Successful applicants will be notified by 31st of March.
